Cell Phone & Electronics Policy

It is Greenfield's policy that students should not have cell phones and electronics on their person during the school day.

- 1. All cell phones and electronic devices should be turned off and placed in student's bag or locker
- 2. If a student is found in possession of or using a cell phone or electronic device during the school day, it will be confiscated immediately by the teacher or staff member.
- 3. Any confiscated item will be taken to the main office.
- 4. Ist Infraction: The principal will return the item to a parent or guardian at their earliest convenience. A parent or guardian will be required to come to school to claim the item.
- 5. 2nd infraction: The principal will return the item to a parent or guardian at the end of the school year. The parent or guardian will be required to come to school to claim the item.
